

KING HENRY'S WALK garden

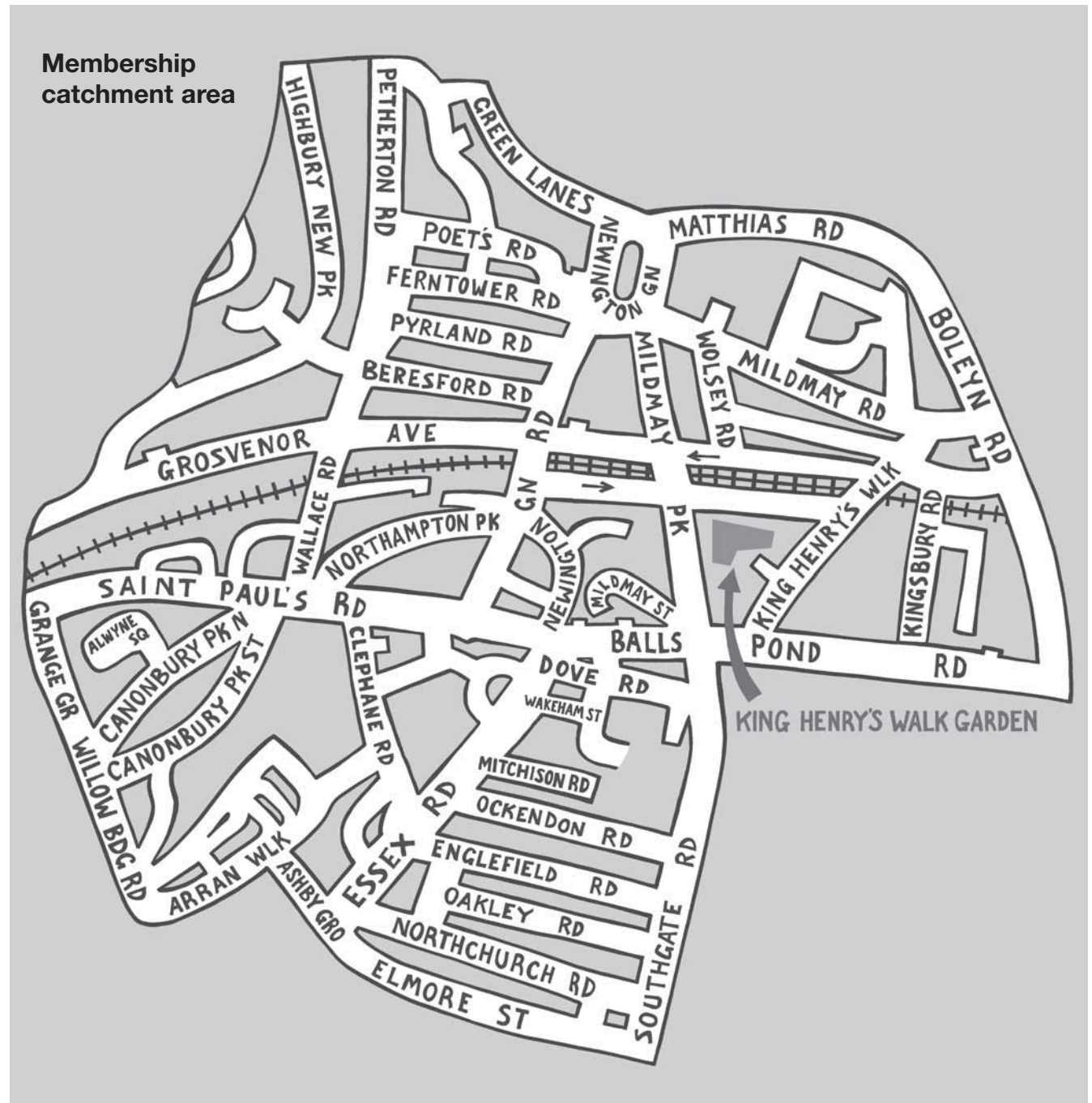
Application for membership

King Henry's Walk Garden is being developed as a community garden with growing plots for local Islington residents (see the catchment area map right). Priority will be given to applicants who don't already have access to a garden. The garden is run and managed by volunteers, and members play an active part in helping with this so, before you apply, please ask yourself if ...

- ✿ you have the time, commitment and energy to care for a plot in all seasons?
- ✿ you are willing to follow organic principles? (We can provide information on organic gardening if required).
- ✿ you are happy to help run the garden by, a) attending workdays and b) helping with practical jobs and events?

If you answer yes to these questions, and live within the catchment area for the garden, then please fill in the application form. Once you have been allocated a plot, a 3-month probationary period will follow. If during this time you haven't looked after the plot, helped out with the running of the garden or haven't adhered to the garden rules, the plot will be re-allocated. We do hope, however, that you enjoy being part of the garden enough to see the extra responsibilities as a pleasure, since members' help is key to making the garden a continuing success.

If a plot is unavailable right now or you don't have the time to look after one, you might want to consider becoming a keyholder member of King Henry's Walk Garden. This means you can have access to the garden, attend and participate in social events, and help out with looking after the garden.
